WIZARD EDUCATION

For ACLS and / or PALS Instructors Planning to Align With and Teach For Wizard Education

- Step 1: Attend a Wizard Education AHA Instructor Course which includes completing a Core Instructor Course. This qualifies you as an Instructor Candidate.
- Step 2: Demonstrate competency teaching one particular ACLS and / or PALS station while being evaluated by Wizard Education AHA Training Center Faculty. Once competency is demonstrated at the chosen station an Instructor Card will be issued for that discipline. Instructor Candidates are not paid for teaching until after competency has been demonstrated.
- Step 3: Instructor can now schedule themselves to teach the above station at any Wizard Education class. At this point you will be paid for teaching that particular station.
- Step 4: You must demonstrate competency at each teaching and evaluation station you wish to teach.

For BLS Instructors Planning to Align With and Teach For Wizard Education

- Step 1:** Register for the upcoming BLS Instructor Course of your choice. Download all necessary paperwork and fax all requested information and completed forms to 623-388-9614.
- Step 2:** Once approved to attend the course and payment is received, you will be mailed your Core Instructor Course and BLS Instructor Manual. Any additional materials will be available for purchase through our AHA materials company Channing Bete. Core Instructor Course must be completed and Certificate of Completion faxed to 623-388-9614 prior to the class date.
- Step 3:** Attending the Wizard Education AHA Instructor Course qualifies you as an Instructor Candidate.
- Step 4:** Opportunities will be available to observe and assist in classes. Once you are comfortable with the material, you must demonstrate competency by teaching either an initial or renewal HCP course while being evaluated by Wizard Education AHA Training Center Faculty. Once competency is demonstrated an Instructor Card will be issued. Instructor Candidates are not paid for teaching until after competency has been demonstrated.
- Step 5:** Instructor can now request to teach at a scheduled course. At this point you will be paid for teaching that particular class.
